207 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Babergh District Council has now adopted its Core Strategy and that as a Neighbourhood Plan should be commensurate with the document, the Parish Council agreed to discuss how to progress.

Cllr V.Durrant suggested the Parish Council should seek confirmation from Babergh District Council of the relevance of the Core Strategy relative to Sproughton. The Council unanimously agreed to ask Nicholas Ridley, District Cllr to facilitate a meeting between Cllr V.Durrant and Cllr J.Kitson and a Babergh District Council officer; the Parish Council would like a better understanding before a decision is made on whether or not to move forward with the development of a Neighbourhood Plan for Sproughton.

The Council unanimously agreed there should be an agenda item to present the community with a brief report of the understanding of a Neighbourhood Plan, at the Annual Parish Meeting to be held on 7th May 2014.
