65. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE TO BE RECEIVED
Cllr S.Curl advised that the Parish Council had received notification of the resignation of Cllr D.Lavington and therefore there were no apologies due.
66. TO ACCEPT MEMBERS DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST
No declarations of interest were received.
67. TO CONFIRM AND SIGN THE MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 5TH SEPTEMBER 2012
The minutes of the meeting held on 5th September 2012, having been circulated to all members, were confirmed and signed as an accurate record of the meeting.
68. REVIEW OF COUNCIL ACTIONS FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 5TH SEPTEMBER 2012
Re. minute no: 12/13 63 District Cllr Jones advised that he had received assurances from Babergh District Council officer, Deborah Board, that she had responded to the issues raised by the Playing Field Management Committee. Cllr B.Askew and Cllr A.Cronin advised that no correspondence had been received, despite Mr D.Lavington, as chairman of the Playing Field Management Committee, having ensured that Ms Board had been provided with his contact details on numerous occasions.
69. TO CONSIDER PLANNING APPLICATION NO: B/12/00950/FUL; PART SIDE GARDEN OF ELVINA, ELTON PARK, SPROUGHTON; ERECTION OF DWELLING AND CREATION OF NEW VEHICULAR ACCESS
The Council unanimously agreed to recommend no objections to planning application no: B/12/000950/FUL. The Council noted that the footprint of the proposed dwelling is substantially larger than the original planning application approved, by Babergh District Council, for this site.

Cllr J.Kitson advised that the development at Rivers Farm, High Street, Sproughton had commenced. He asked the Council to consider asking for cautionary road signage to be erected during the construction period, following a road traffic accident which occurred whilst construction vehicles were moving on and off the site. The Council agreed to inform Babergh District Council of the matter.

Cllr H.Davies asked if there was any progress to report regarding the development of the traveller site, at Lorraine Way, Bramford. There was no progress to report.
