- 102 TO ACCEPT MEMBERS DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

- 103 TO CONFIRM AND SIGN THE MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 4TH DECEMBER 2013

- 105 SPROUGHTON/BRAMFORD CYCLE PATH
Cllr V.Durrant advised that the Parish Council had been approached by Mr D. Golding, of Bramford regarding a petition, seeking community support, for the footpath between Sproughton and Bramford being officially upgraded to a cycle/footpath.

- 106 TO CONSIDER PLANNING APPLICATION NO: B/13/01495/TPO; SPROUGHTON COURT, SPROUGHTON; WORKS TO 16 NO. TREES - LIFTING CROWNS, REDUSING BRANCHES/DEADWOODING AND REMOVAL OF EPICORMIC GROWTH
The Parish Council unanimously agreed to recommend no objections to planning application no: B/13/01495/TPO.
- 107 ACOLAID CASE B/13/00774
Mr P.Cobbold, planning consultant and Mr G.Cook, the owner of the Russets development site, Haldeigh Road, Sproughton, addressed the Council and advised that a revised, stand alone application for the development of the site is being considered. The application would look to address the objections of the Parish Council and Babergh District Council of planning application no: B/13/00774. Mr P.Cobbold circulated an indicative, alternative layout of a development to the Council and described how it would address some of the objective issues raised.

Cllr S.Curl advised that any comments the Parish Council had made during Mr Cobbold's presentation were informal and any formal comments would be submitted when a formal application had been made.
