Sproughton Mitigation Measures (SMM). Cllr V.Durrant has asked both Mid Suffolk District Council and Suffolk County Council to provide him with statements against their positions regarding the S106 SMM; he intends to forward the statements for publication in the January 2015 issue of the 'In Touch' magazine, as an update for the Parish. At this time, he has not received the statements. At the meeting, Cllr V.Durrant had asked why Sproughton Parish Council had not been included as a consultee of Mid Suffolk District Council planning application no: 3310/14. On 24th November 2014, at 16:40, an email was received from Mr P. Isbell, of Mid Suffolk District Council, inviting the Parish Council to submit any comments relating to the application, by 15th December 2014.
