- 16 TO ACCEPT MEMBERS DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST
Cllr K.Barwick, Cllrs S.Curl, Cllr H.Davies and Cllr P.Powell advised they had been granted dispensations which permitted them to take part in any discussions and decisions relating to the proposed Wolsey Grange development.

- 19 Neighbourhood Community Led Plan

- 20 Wolsey Grange Update

The Parish Council had received a request from East Bergholt Parish Council, asking for copies of the Parish Council's exchange of legal letters with Babergh District Council, relating to the proposed Wolsey Grange application. The Council agreed to ask for further clarification from East Bergholt Parish Council.
Cllr S.Curl called an extraordinary Parish Council meeting to be held on 17th/ 18th May 2016, in order that the Parish Council can evaluate the status of the pursuance of a Judicial Review.
Cllr P.Powell advised he had not received a satisfactory response from Babergh District Council, regarding his F.O.I. request, and has now passed the matter on to the I.C.O.
