- 67 MATTERS RAISED BY MEMBERS
Cllr H.Davies reported she had attended a BAPTC meeting on the 8th August 2016, at which they had discussed the Babergh District Council SHELAA. To note was site SPR02 - land between London Road and Hadleigh Road, where the summary table stated that "submission states that the intension is to cooperate" this related to a covenant preventing property from being used for development. It was agreed that Cllr H.Davies would contact the beneficiary of the covenant to clarify. BAPTC members agreed to ask their respective district cllrs the six questions that John Foster had proposed re. email of Cllr H.Davies of 28th September 2016. It was agreed that the Council would put these six questions to our district cllrs at the next council meeting and ask them for a formal response.

Cllr P.Powell reminded the meeting that it should be careful when discussing sensitive and potentially privileged matters in public and should consider in appropriate circumstances to exclude the public from the meeting.
