The Clerk had received a response from the Clerk to the SPA, which indicated likely membership costs, and how they would be proportionally charged to members. As the SnOasis application is likely to produce only a single issue concern for Sproughton (traffic associated), which can be dealt with 'in house', and that the Council is low on people resources, the Council unanimously agreed to support the group in principle but not to join SPA; the Parish Council agreed to keep SPA informed of any associated submissions it may make to MSDC.
