

The Tithe Barn

This late 16th or early 17th Century *Grade II Listed* Tithe Barn is owned and maintained by Sproughton Parish Council. The Barn is connected via a covered walkway to a modern kitchen, a well-equipped meeting room (known as the Barley Room) and lavatory facilities (inc.disabled) plus baby changing.



From barn dances to beer festivals to indoor sports/exercise, the Sproughton Tithe Barn complex caters for a variety of activities. The main Barn measures 7 by 30 m and is licensed to hold the following maximum numbers of persons at events: -

- 120 seated at tables;
- 300 as a seated audience;
- 300 dancing only;
- 150 mixed (tables/chairs and dancing).



The Barn, Barley Room and kitchen are available for hire, separately or all together as a whole package.

The Barley Room, was created in 2006, to provide an alternate meeting space for the village and local organizations.

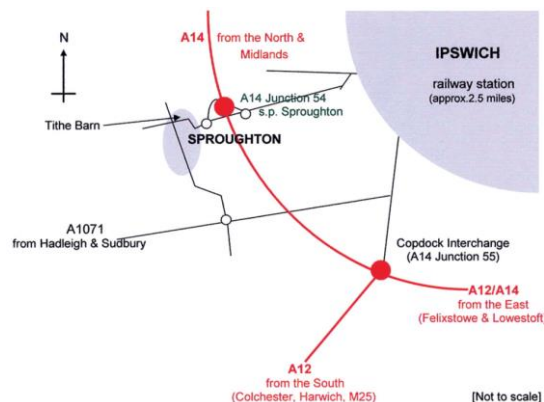


The room is equipped to accommodate a variety of formats, for example, 10 people seated at desks using lap-tops at an IT seminar, 24 people seated at tables to eat, or 30 people seated as an audience for a film show.

The Tithe Barn and Barley Room are located in Lower Street, Sproughton, within a few yards of the River Gipping, Millennium Green and All Saints' Church. Off-street parking is provided for a dozen or more cars, with overspill parking possible in adjacent minor roads. Sproughton village is located about two and a half miles west of Ipswich town centre with its main line rail station, on a bus route, and half a mile from the Sproughton junction (junction 54) on the A14. For GPS and satnav users, the post code is **IP8 3AA**.
